- 1. 1st Prize winner receives 1 x return air fare to Florence Italy with 4 nights' accommodation and 2 to 3 days tuition by renowned fresco artist Emanuele Capozza.
- 2. Alternative 1st prize is \$3,000 cash. (1. or 2. Sponsored by FSR Equip)
- 3. People's Choice Award will receive \$1,000 cash. (Sponsored by are-able)
- 4. The Highly Commended Award will receive a Sponsors' Prize.
- 5. The competition is open to artists who are from or who have connections to Southwest Victoria.
- 6. Portrait subjects must be currently or previously active in their community and recognised as a significant community volunteer or philanthropist. They must also be currently residing in or have previously resided in the Local Government Areas of Warrnambool, Moyne, or Corangamite.
- 7. The Portrait can be in any form provided it portrays the subject recognisably and appropriately.
- 8. Limit of one Warrnibald entry per Artist.
- 9. Entries must not be self-portraits.
- 10. The chosen portrait subject must consent in writing by signing the Entry Form. Entries must include a brief biography between 100 and 200 words of both Portrait Subject and the Artists' motivation for choosing their subject. The biography will accompany the artwork in the exhibition. The biography may be edited at the discretion of the organising committee.
- 11. All portraits must be available for sale at the price set by the artist. The price must include a 30% commission retained by Warrnambool & District Community Hospice at the time of the sale.
- 12. Artwork's frame size from the outside edge must measure no larger than 105cms W x 105cms H x 10cms D. All entries must be ready for display, framed and ready to hang with picture wire attached.
- 13. Sculpture must be easily carried, freestanding, stable, secure and ready to display.

- 14. Artworks are to be labelled clearly on the back or base with **Title of the Portrait, Artist's Name and Phone Number.**
- 15. Artworks that do not meet the above eligibility criteria will not be eligible for exhibition. The Hospice Art Event Organising Committee reserves the right to exclude artwork from the exhibition which they deem to be inappropriate, offensive, or not in the spirit of the event. In the event an artwork is excluded from the exhibition the total relevant entry fee amount will be refunded.
- 16. If the number of entries exceeds the available display space, numbers may be restricted to those received first.
- 17. Entries close on the 28th April 2025.
- 18. Your portrait work is to be delivered to the Warrnambool Racecourse Matilda Room on **Thursday 8**th **May 2025** between **2PM and 5PM**.
- 19. The judging will take place on **Friday 9th May 2025**. Prize money and proceeds of the sale of your artwork will be paid by EFT the week commencing **19th May**. You will be contacted by the Organising Committee to supply your bank account details for the transfer of prize money or payment for artwork sold.
- 20. Artwork will be displayed at the Matilda Room from Friday 9th May 2025 until Wednesday 14th May 2025 between 10AM and 4PM daily.
- 21. Artwork will then be moved to The F Project Arts Precinct in Timor Street where it will be displayed from Wednesday 21st May 2025 until Sunday 8th June 2025. Gallery hours are 10AM to 4PM Wednesday to Sunday.
- 22. Artwork is to be collected from The F Project on Sunday 8th June 2025 between 3PM and 4PM.
- 23. Entry fee of \$40 for the *Warrnibald* Portrait Prize (Concession \$30 Age Pension or Health Care Cards) must be received by the Organising Committee by the closing date and can be paid by EFT to:
